



UK Departure from the European Union

The United Kingdom is scheduled to leave the E.U. on the 29th March 2019.

As negotiations continue, many industries are making contingency plans to ensure continuation of service, and to protect their supply chains.

Qolcom has worked with its major suppliers to determine their plans over the coming period. Many suppliers have created dedicated Brexit teams, while others are working with Government agencies and international trade freight advisors, to evaluate the different potential outcomes of the Brexit process.

Qolcom's major suppliers have advised us that they do not expect any significant impact on supplies and expect to maintain their service commitments. This applies both to their stock-holding of core products, and to the logistics provision of their AEO (Authorised Economic Operator) freight partners.

Some uncertainty remains, awaiting clarification by UK Government or HM Customs. However based on known status as of 1st December 2018 , we do not expect any short or medium term risk to our supply chain.
